#### Classroom Procedures:

**Social Distancing:** Third graders are expected to maintain at least 3 feet of social distance from one another to the greatest extent possible during the school day

- Desks are in socially distanced formations that adhere to these guidelines
- There are dot markers inside and outside the classroom to help remind students

Masks: Third graders MUST wear their masks at all times while in the classroom environment

## 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Essentials

#### Lunch & Recess:

**Cafeteria:** Students will eat lunch as a classroom group (single cohort) assigned to a section of tables

 Tables will have dots indicating where students need to sit; these dots will be color coded for classroom cohorts

Recess: Masks are not required, but social distancing is adhered to

Games that involve physical contact will not be permitted

#### Visitors:

- No visitors are allowed into the school/classrooms. If a parent needs to drop something off for their student, physical distancing guidelines and mask requirements are adhered to in the school foyer
  - No more than one person is allowed in the foyer at a time (must be wearing a mask)
  - If the foyer is busy, parents need to wait outside the building until it is clear
  - Any items being dropped off must be labeled with your student's name and grade level
