READING

Weekly Message:

This week, students will read a nonfiction article from Storyworks Jr. with a focus on vocabulary, nonfiction text features, and evidence from the text.

Learning Targets:

I can identify text evidence, cause and effect, and draw conclusions from a nonfiction text.

Lessons:

LESSON 1:

Students read a nonfiction article and identify correct usage of vocabulary terms. (vocabulary assignment)

LESSON 2:

Students use background knowledge and text evidence to identify details and support statements.

(text evidence assignment)

LESSON 1:

Students select the best answer to multiple choice questions and craft written responses that call for the use of examples from the text. (quiz)

WRITING

Weekly Message:

This week students will practice writing a stoplight paragraph.

Learning Targets:


I can plan, draft, edit, and revise an organized paragraph using the stoplight writing pattern.

Lessons:

LESSON 1:

Students will create a plan using a graphic organizer that centers on what they did over Spring Break. Students may print the organizer and write directly on it, or they can use the electronic version.

MATH

Weekly Message:

This week students will review what we have already learned about geometric concepts.

Learning Targets:

I can identify different shapes and their attributes. I can construct arguments and critique the reasoning of others.

Lessons:

LESSON 1:

Students will look at four shapes (using this <u>website</u>) and identify which shape doesn't belong. Students will share their thinking on Google Classroom.

LESSON 2:

Students will complete a math review activity page

LESSON 3:

Students will access math games and activities from links on Minatta Classroom-> Student Resources

Assignments:

- Read article, "Attack From Outer Space"

LESSON 2:

Students will use their plan to write a paragraph that follows the stoplight format. The paragraph should be typed and submitted in Google Classroom.
